DUATHLON

1. How are TEAM USA spots allocated in the duathlon races.

2020 Duathlon Nationals qualifies for 2021 Duathlon worlds. The specifics can be found on at: https://www.teamusa.org/usa-triathlon/events/national-championships/2020/2020-duathlon-national-championships/team-usa

For standard distance, top 18 qualify rolling down to the 30th spot. For non-draft sprint, top 8 qualify. For draft-legal sprint, top 10 qualify rolling down to the 30 spot. Both sprint races qualify for the DL Sprint Du Worlds – there is no non-draft sprint at worlds. All athletes will get an email from USAT if they qualified about 2-3 weeks after the race.
